
With exactly 30 days to go until the US election, the impact of the Sept 10 Harris-Trump debate is now evident in the polls, with VP Kamala Harris modestly expanding her lead in both national and swing state polling. However, the race remans "too-close-to-call" with polling differentials still within the margin of error, especially in the key swing state of Pennsylvania (see below).

Thirty days is a long time in Washington. As happened over the last week (Hurricane Helene, Middle East, labor strikes), we expect more "October surprises" and movement in polls in the weeks ahead.
